Age Criteria:

- ❖ Children born between 1st October 2020 and 30th September 2021.
- ❖ The child should have completed 3 years and 6 months as on 1st April 2025.

Admission Procedure

Admissions are granted in MVM to students based on their previous mark report and personal interview with the student from grade I upwards and a parental interaction for Pre-Nursery and KG and meeting the admissions criteria.

- 1) Submit the online Enquiry Form from this website or visit the school admission office.
- 2) The Person In-charge for admission will get back to you to answer your questions and collect the required information.
- 3) Parents / Guardian will visit school campus to fill in the Pre-Admission form
- 4) The School Admission department would direct you for parental interaction.
- 5) Student appears for parental interaction for Nursery. Aptitude tests for KG classes and above, whatever is applicable.
- 6) Student Registration & Payment of fees to be done within 7 working days.

Note: School text books can be purchased on announced date

A Note to Parents

- The Hand Book is the most effective medium of Parent Teacher communication. Parents are requested to check the Hand Book daily, look in for homework endorsement made by the teacher and to communicate their queries through the Hand Book.
- > Parents who seek information or wish to make suggestion should do so to the Principal. The Principal can only be met on all working days during the Visitor's timings.
